So, understanding that many men will connect with this kind of activity, the deacons are committed to exploring other outdoor related events for 2012 with the aim to win men to Christ. Thank you for your prayers in this regard.

"Courageous" the movie

In the months of March and April we are planning to use the movie, "Courageous," as an outreach with men/couples as the primary targets.

You will have the first opportunity to see the movie on February 24.

In turn, I am asking you to get involved in helping us to reach out to couples for the March 24 viewing and to the law enforcement community for the April 21 viewing. For these two nights, we are planning to include a meal with the movie. If we are to be successful, we will need volunteers to help with publication, meal preparation, serving, and child care.

MISSIONS

Dear Pastor Jack,

I hope you and your family are doing well. We are excited to see new doors of ministry God has begun to open to us.

I want to share with you a need we have which would cost your people nothing but be very valuable to us and our ministry. Sheila and I are starting an education program through our Honduran church. We have discovered a computer based educational program accepted by the Honduran government. This is exciting because it allows people to progress through grades at their own pace. One young lady we know about completed three years of school in one year. We plan to open our church up and provide the opportunity for the very poor to come in and continue their education. What an evangelistic opportunity as we are the hands and feet of Christ. This provides a desperately needed service.

The majority of the very poor in Honduras have little education and thus few opportunities to improve their lot in life. The good employers in Honduras will not hire anyone with less than a sixth grade education. In order to get a good job, you need to have graduated from the eleventh grade. School is free in Honduras but without supplies and a uniform, children are not allowed to attend. For the very poor the choice is often between education and food, food wins. In order for an adult Honduran to go back to school and continue their limited education they must attend one full year for each grade.

There is no GED program and home schooling is not legal.

What we need. GOOD USED LAPTOPS

Could you ask your church members to consider donating their old functioning laptops to our ministry? With Christmas having just past, it is possible that some people have purchased new Laptops and do not need their old ones. It does not matter if they are old. Our educational program runs well on Windows XP. We would like to start our educational ministry outreach at the end of February. Sheila will be back in the States Feb. 12th through the 20th visiting her mother in CA. We would like for her to be able to bring at least 10 laptops or netbooks back to Honduras with her. Our prayer and goal is to receive 20 donated laptops for this first effort. My Mother will be collecting the computers for us. She lives in Jacksonville. Here is her phone number 910-938-3638.
